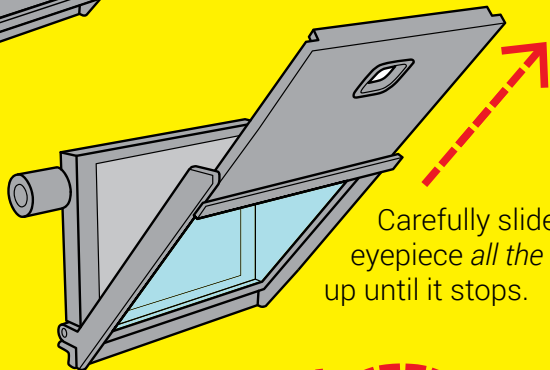


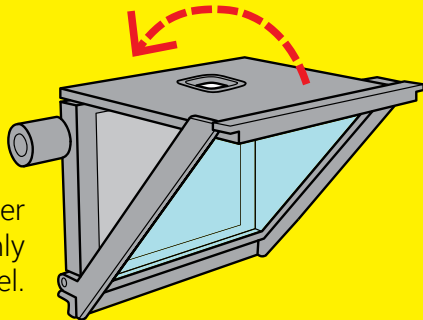
Gently open eyepiece.

up until it stops.

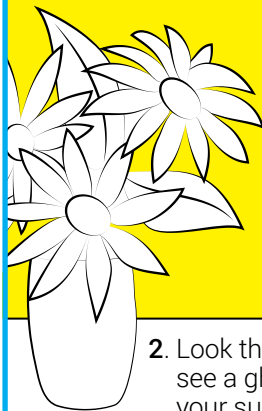

on rear panel.

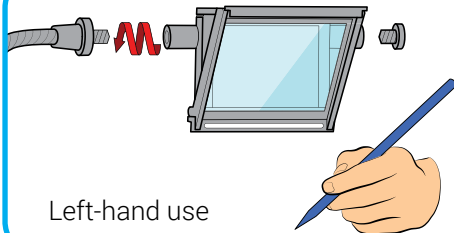

your subject and over your paper.

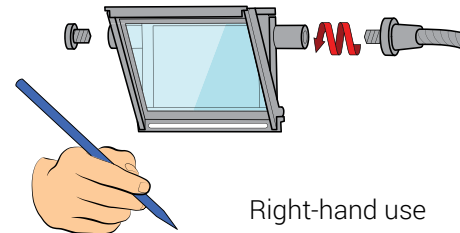


2. Look through eyepiece to

3. Trace what you see!



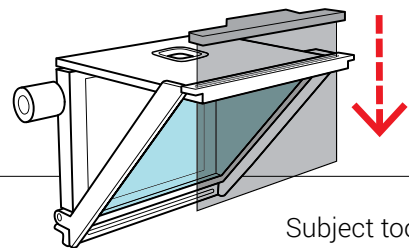

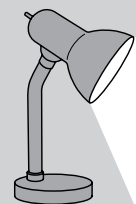
The NeoLucida XL works best with equal lighting between your paper and your subject. If lighting is imbalanced, use the shader provided.



Subject too bright?
Place shader in front.



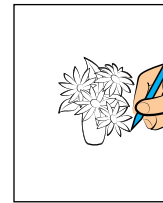
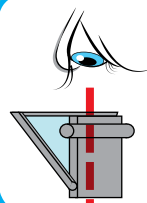
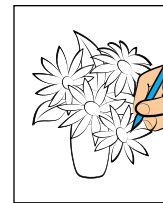
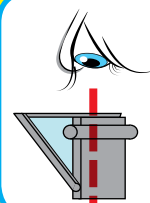
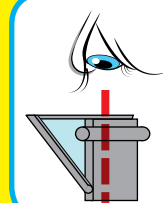
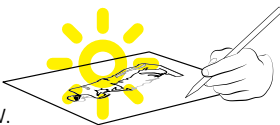
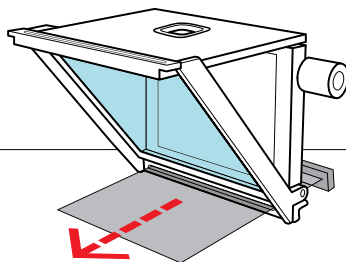
Tip: Keep shader in rear pocket when not in use.
